

Stripping and re-roofing an old failed asbestos roof and cladding



The Client: Bradnam Joinery

Location: Hollands Road Haverhill

The Cost: £130000

The Project:

The client bought this old warehouse and wished to renovate and modernise to increase his warehousing facility.

Roof: 950m² old asbestos. Stripped and re-roofed in 3 weeks using Kingspan KS1000RW 115mm composite.

Rooflights: 10% of floor area included insulated panels.


Cladding: 300m². Stripped and re-clad using Kingspan KS1000RW 80mm composite.

External eaves gutters replaced using "Trimline"

Valley gutters replaced with new galvanised section and insulated from below to maintain size and girth and avoid "cold spots".

Health & Safety was planned and completed by Belmont Roofing to meet joint legal responsibilities.
